To be vaccinated against the coronavirus, you can visit a vaccination point:

- from the age of 12
- by appointment
- for residents of Antwerp, Schoten, Stabroek, Wommelgem or Borsbeek
- for your first vaccine, second vaccine or third vaccine (please note: you will only be given a third vaccine if you have received a new invitation specifically to this end)

Accessible for people with a disability

- Staff on site can answer your practical questions.
- People with a disability or reduced mobility may bring an escort. This could be a carer, interpreter or helper.
- Blind or partially sighted people may also bring their guide dog.
- The vaccination points are easily accessible to wheelchair users. Everything takes place on the ground floor.
