Siberiabrug bridge can be opened 24/7 on request (phone: +32 (0) 3 229 72 09).

Attention, no passage possible from Monday to Friday

at these times: 6.30 am till 9 am
1.15 pm till 1.45 pm
3 pm till 6 pm

At these times, shipping is interrupted.

Londenbrug (VHF 62) B

Londenbrug bridge opens daily at set times. You must request the opening of the bridge. (Phone: +32 (0) 3 229 72 09).

Kattendijk Lock (VHF 69)

This lock is open to pleasure craft and passenger vessels with a maximum measurement of: LOA 90.00 * BOA 12.00 * Draft 3.00 m.

Kattendijk Lock is in operation:

- from Monday till Saturday: from 6 am until 10 pm.
- on Sundays and public holidays (from Easter until 30 September): from 9 am until 7 pm

Important! Kattendijk Lock is a tidal lock.

Berths: During the 2020 season, passenger vessels can moor

at the following berths:
• S15 (bollards 170-179)
• S16 (bollards 179-190)
• S17A (bollards 190-199)

Attention: For safety reasons and for the comfort of passengers, only 1 vessel may moor alongside.

Kattendiikdok-Westkaai G

3 x LOA 135m of 4 x LOA 110m Capacity:

Shore power: Yes.

> Shore power points are available along Kattendijkdok-Westkaai. Vessels that are moored here must connect to a Shore power point. The shipping company must have completed the registration for the use of Shore power prior to the vessel's arrival in the City Port. Generators are banned. Anyone who does not connect to a Shore power point risks being

fined (Gemeentelijke Administratieve Sactie, GAS)

Rerths: A new arrangement took effect on 1/1/2020 for all berths

> along Kattendijkdok-Westkaai. The intention is to make maximum use of the available Shore power points. That is why vessels may no longer moor alongside at berths 15A and 16B. Ships are only planned alongside at quay 15B-16A, where

there are 2 Shore power points.

Currently there are no other quays in the City Port with Shore power points. Vessels that moor along other guays than Kattendijkdok-Westkaai must generate their own

electrical power.

Kattendijkdok-Oostkaai H

Capacity: 4 x LOA 135m

Shore power: No. Vessels must generate their own electrical power.

Willemdok 1

Capacity: $2 \times LOA \le 90 \text{ m of } 4 \times \le 60 \text{ m of } 6 \times \le 40 \text{ m}$

Walstroom: No. Vessels must generate their own electrical power.

Verbindinasdok-Westkaai Capacity: $1 \times LOA \leq 70 \text{ m}$

Deliveries

Almost all the front quays in the City Port are designated as cycling and pedestrian zones. Parking is strictly forbidden here. Deliveries are allowed from 6 am until 10 pm. All the information about deliveries in the City Port can be found here:

Шorks

Do you want to perform maintenance and repair work or diving on or near your vessel or infrastructure? You must always request the authorisation of City Port services for this.

Works are strictly forbidden at these locations:

- Kattendijkdok-Westkaai
- Willemdok
- Verbindingsdok

Using a dinghy for works is strictly forbidden.

Vessel cleaning

You may clean the vessel with water. You may clean on board or on quay. You may not use a dinghy for cleaning.

Parking for touring coaches

You can park for longer than 30 minutes in the car park along d'Herbouvillekaai.

The car park is free. There is no need to reserve a parking space.

There are Kiss & Ride zones along Cockerillkaai and Plantinkaai and near Kattendijkdok-Westkaai and Kattendijkdok-Oostkaai. Passengers can be picked up or dropped off here. You can find all the information about parking facilities for touring coaches here:
