**SUPERA**

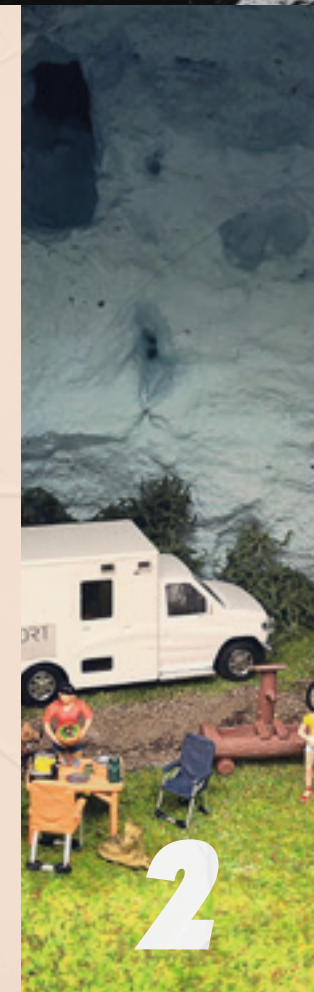
**LOCATION**  
Haringrodestraat 86-104

**INFO**  
Dutch artist Super A from Goes previously visited Berchem and painted a few beautiful pigeons on the parking lot at the Coveliersstraat. Unfortunately, during a renovation, the mural was lost. Thankfully, less than a year later, he returned to paint a new version across the street, even bigger and more majestic!

**INFO**  
During spring cleaning several years ago, Elke Lemmens worked on the facade of her house. She decided to paint an old rusted 'scraper' (a notch next to the front door historically used to clean your shoes) in gold. The end result just begged for a creative statement. Elke created a miniature camping installation, drawing happy reactions from neighbors. The project expanded, and there now are many small art installations to be seen across town.

Woeringenstraat 2

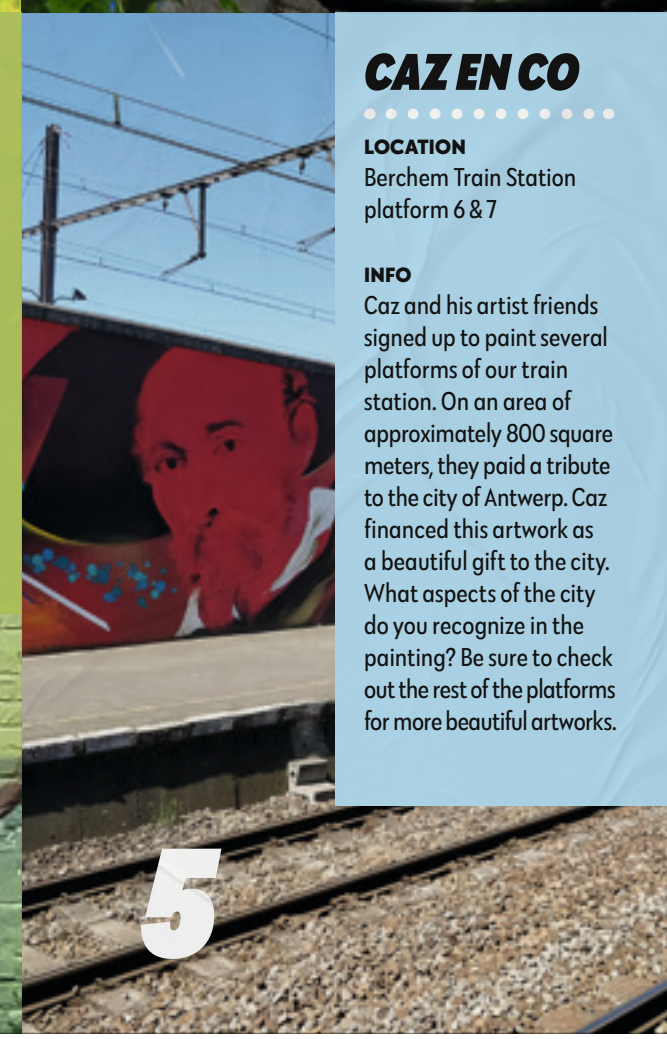
**INFO**  
A remarkable work by local artist Smok, who is known for his realistic animal portraits. This one is inspired by a picture of a dad who blogs about the adventures of his son Will. Driekoningenstraat 132

**INFO**  
Another gem from Smok who quite literally highlighted the birthday party of foundation 'De Goudhaantjes' with this golden rooster. You can find the work in the neighborhood garden next to the cultural center.



**CAZEN CO**

**LOCATION**  
Berchem Train Station platform 6 & 7

**INFO**  
Caz and his artist friends signed up to paint several platforms of our train station. On an area of approximately 800 square meters, they paid a tribute to the city of Antwerp. Caz financed this artwork as a beautiful gift to the city. What aspects of the city do you recognize in the painting? Be sure to check out the rest of the platforms for more beautiful artworks.



## MR JUNE & RISE ONE

### LOCATION

#### INFO

This artwork was created by local artist Rise One, with a commissioned assignment for the right side, but full creative freedom to do what he saw fit for the left side of the wall. Together with the Dutch artist Mr June, he painted his name on the wall. Make sure to check the level of detail in the water drops that Mr June loves to incorporate in his work.

### LOCATION

Viaduct Guldenvliesstraat

#### INFO

Under the railway bridge, Rise One recreated a scene from the popular game 'Assassin's Creed'. The developers of the game (Ubisoft) have offices in Berchem and decided to use this mural as part of the launch campaign of the new game!

## MEETING OF STYLES

### LOCATION

Minkelerstraat, Vlijtstraat & Uitbreidingstraat

#### INFO

Every summer, the internationally renowned graffiti festival 'Meeting of Styles' lands in the streets around the 'Zomerfabriek'. Artists from all over the world visit Antwerp to give the 3000m² of walls a spectacular new appearance. This is why graffiti and street art fans visit this place on a yearly basis.

## RISE ONE

### LOCATION

Tramhalte  
Antwerpen-Harmonie

#### INFO

The old 'De Lijn' building has been transformed into a 'social sculpture' that includes travelers and passers-by: in large bright red block letters, 'people' refers to the waiting people and the design slyly refers to a well-known parcel service. On the side and back, all kinds of cartoon characters are waiting for the next tram together with the people.

### LOCATION

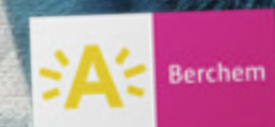
Lange Lozanastraat 146

## ARTOON

### LOCATION

Bikschotelaan 130

#### INFO

Artoon painted a fitting scene on two sides of 'De Boomhut', an elementary school in Berchem. On one side, a kid explores the world with binoculars. On the other side a colorful toucan observing it all. This is a way for school to communicate it's core values to parents and neighbors: transparency, safety, sustainability and being connected.

## K.SHIT, EL TIPO & SMOK

### LOCATION

Generaal Lemanstraat, fietserstunnel

#### INFO

Smok asked a few fellow artists to collaborate on the bicycle tunnel. El Tipo works with text, K.Shit combines abstract with illustrative shapes and Smok, as you know by now, paints in a realistic style. Water was the central theme and formed the base of the project. Amongst other subjects, you'll be able to spot some of the animals that live in the Brialmont Park.

## CHASE, BUÉ THE WARRIOR & ZENITH

### LOCATION

Posthofbrug

#### INFO

The iconic trio known as 'Buck' returned to Antwerp years later and made a powerful statement ("Open your mind before your mouth") just next to the highway. This reunion did not come easy, all three artists spend most of their lives abroad: Chase lives in Los Angeles, Bué in Mexico and Zenith (better known as Matthias Schoenaerts) travels the world as an actor. Use the bicycle bridge by the station to reach the artwork.

## RISE ONE

### LOCATION

Roderveldlaan 2

#### INFO

For "I want naft", Rise One created this artwork and integrated all elements of this cultural project, which supports creative youth culture in many ways. You can recognize different disciplines in the mural, such as music, photography and urban sports. Which other disciplines can you spot?

## AEROSOL-KINGS

### LOCATION

Binnenplein 16

#### INFO

The sides of garage walls are loved by graffiti artists. This neighborhood wanted to brighten up the area and asked Skill and Rise One of the Aerosolkings to unleash their talent. The result is colorful graffiti with realistic detail.

## RED LION ART HOUSE

### LOCATION

Rode leeuwlaan 15

#### INFO

Red Lion Art House is a hidden gem near Deurne airport, an old industrial building has been transformed into a creative hub where artists and entrepreneurs live together and inspire each other. All the interior and exterior walls of this building have been blessed by befriended artists that drop by when they are traveling in the area.
